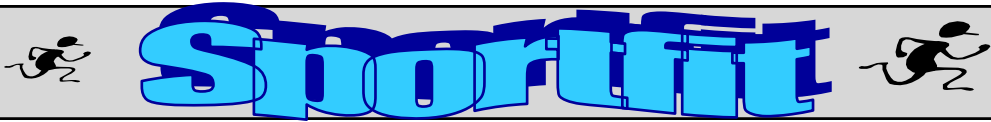

mention of the adult coaches and managers for Netball, Jessica Patchett, Jill Mead and Kerri Brownlie.

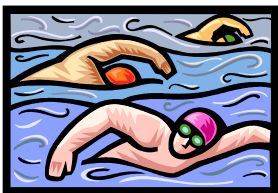
